PRIME-Members confirmed managing board at duty

The latest member assembly of the Print Media Network e.V. (short PRIME) after the IfraExpo 2006 in Amsterdam confirmed the three-headed managing board for another year in duty. The managing board's chairman remains chairman of the business-leaders of Ahrensburg's Systemhouse EAE Ewert Ahrensburg Electronic, Heiko Schröder. His fellows are again Stephan Bäuerle (Manager Funkinform) and Wolfgang Felber (Assistant Manager Print at ABB).

During the assembly the members drew a positive balance of the past work. Schröder said the expectations have been outdone. Nine interfaces are supposedly defined between the single production systems. All Schnittstellen are successful in production in different installations.

At base of a member – defined, standardized process picture (workflow) for the publishing- and printing area, all of the interface in the printing area have been defined and realized in projects.

So for every print machine, that is involved with Print Media networks the standardized PRIME interface will be used in case of a reinvestment or new machine. This success is pioneering in Heiko Schröder's eyes.
